

Dress Code

Personal Hygiene

The personal grooming of each student should be in accord with the standards set by the uniform dress code. Students should be clean and neat when at school.

All Students

Uniforms will help us ensure mutual respect for all while providing a focused, comfortable, disciplined learning environment. Parents and guardians are responsible for the appropriate fitting of all clothing so that it is appropriately sized to the individual. Uniforms must be worn throughout the entire academic day including electives, tutoring, detention, and field trips. Our high school uniform colors are white, navy blue, or black (with embossed school crest) for shirts/sweaters and navy blue or khaki for pants/shorts/skirts. School uniform colors do not include variations such as turquoise, purple, brown, or gold. Sample colors are available in the school office. These must be solid colors and students may not wear clothing with logos or symbols or with any pattern. The school logo is allowed. School spirit wear may only be worn on Fridays. A sweater or fleece may be worn only over a uniform shirt. Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee. Gentlemen must keep shirts neatly tucked. School administration has ultimate decision-making authority on dress code violations.

Students may choose from the following school uniforms:

Visible Undershirt (worn under a dress code shirt)	T-shirt or tank top	White, navy blue, or black
Pants	Dress slacks of cotton twill chino material <i>No leggings/tights</i> <i>No denim material</i>	Navy blue, or khaki
Shorts, Skirts, Capris	Cotton twill chino material <i>No denim material</i>	Navy blue or khaki
Belts	Free from spikes, jewels, or other objects <i>Suspenders are not allowed</i>	White, navy blue, brown, black, or khaki
Shoes	Closed-toe matching dress or athletic (may be multi-dress code colored)	White, navy blue, brown, gray, or black
Visible Socks (athletic, dress, knee high), tights, leggings and hosiery	Cotton, wool, lycra, closed-knit (not fishnet or open weave) <i>Worn under dress code</i>	White, navy blue, orange, or black

Neck scarves or ties	Solid or patterned fabric	White, navy blue, orange, or black
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Please note that the following are not permitted:

- Backpacks and oversized bags are not permitted in classrooms. Only small purses, TPHS cinch bags, and laptop sleeves that fit in the storage space under a desk or completely under a chair are permitted in classrooms.
- Hats, bandanas, sweat bands, forehead coverings, or head coverings of any kind. Students must remove all head coverings immediately upon entering the building and may not put them back on until they leave the building.
- Boots except as outerwear.
- Extreme hairstyles and body piercings. Hair color for boys and girls must be of natural tones.
- Wearing, carrying or displaying gang paraphernalia, names, signs or symbols of gang membership.
- Exposed undergarments.
- Jewelry or accessories with spikes, inappropriate lettering, decorations, or advertisements.

Students who are in violation of the dress code will be sent to the office where they will be required to dress appropriately prior to returning to class or be sent home. Chronic violation of the dress code may result in suspension and other disciplinary consequences.

Students should contact school administration if there are difficulties complying with the dress code policy for religious reasons.
